

“If anyone serves me, he must follow me; and where I am, there my servant will be also.” (Jn 12: 26) With these words, the Lord Jesus tells his disciples about his approaching sufferings and death, preparing them for the hardships that lay ahead on Good Friday. He foresaw the rejection of the chief priests, the unjust condemnation by Pilate, the long walk to Calvary, and his death on the Cross. To be a good and faithful servant of Christ is to follow him on this journey; he invites his disciples, “Walk with me; stay with me; come along with me as we walk this necessary road to the Cross.”

The Church obeys this command every year through the rituals of the sacred liturgy and the traditions of our Faith. The three age-old Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving bring us to imitate Christ in his Passion, while the liturgies of Lent sacramentally join us to Christ through his grace, helping us to relive his sufferings and death.

Perhaps more than at any other time of the year, the words of Christ pertain to the practices of Lent, “If anyone serves me, he must follow me; and where I am, there my servant will be also.” Join us during this sacred season so that, becoming one with the Lord in his sufferings, we may also be one with him in his glory.

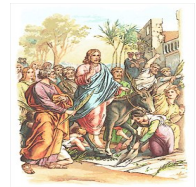
